## Treasurer and Financial Report

Gale Nichols distributed an up to date financial report of the Profit and Loss and Balance Sheet to the attendees. She noted that there has not been much activity since the last meeting.

Gale reported that in the final accounting of Jazz Under the Stars, over \$9600 was made. They would like to present them with a large card signed by the kids at semi-state in addition to special recognition on Marching Band Recognition night Nov. 25. They will also do a card for the Brennans and Kisers.

The Band directories are done. Thank you to Darlene Pratt, Becky Connor and Jeannette Smedberg for a job well done.

A request for volunteers to staff the Fall Concerts will go out at the beginning of November.

## Directors Report—Janis Stockhouse and Thomas Wilson

Tom Wilson reported that he is still waiting to hear about BHSN Marching Band's potential participation in the Bands of America event that takes place November 8 at Lucas Oil Stadium.

Tom would like to purchase some strobe lights for the finale of the Marching Band show. The expense of roughly \$150 was approved.

Janis was thrilled to report that Jamey Aebersold has agreed to be the honorary guest artist at the Bloomington Jazz Fest.
