#### ***Treasurer's Report***

The budget was approved.

March-a-thon: A proposal to hold a march-a-thon was discussed. Timing: during mini-camp? Sponsorships: per lap? Straight fee? A march-a-thon requires about two weeks lead time in order to collect money from sponsors. Janis to talk with Tom.

#### ***Director's Report***

Janis thanked everyone who participated in and/or donated to the ECA fundraising effort.

The issue of needing to increase recruiting efforts at the middle school level was raised.

Pontiac, Michigan (Silverdome)/Bands of America regional: Scheduled for Friday–Saturday, October 8–9, 2010. Janis obtained quotes on charter busses of \$3,000 per bus (Star Bus Line). The cost per student will be approximately \$60 for the bus and \$100 for one-night stay in hotel.

JUTS will take place on Friday, August 27 from 6:30–8:30 p.m. in a revised format: \$35 per person to cover hors d'oeuvres and lemonade or ice tea. Wine and soft drinks to be available for purchase. Susie requested additional volunteers: 4 students who aren't playing to help with parking, volunteers to help staff the welcome table (not ticket table—tickets this year will be virtual), 2 volunteers to help with wine sales (will need to obtain temporary liquor license).
