Treasurer's Report

Gale Nichols distributed the BHSN Band Profit & Loss sheet July 1, 2009 through May 12, 2010. She estimates that the Band Booster's net income, after expenses, will be approximately \$2K to 3K (not the \$6398.35 shown on Budget vs. Actual).

Gale will open another CD to put in any new donations to the Endowment Fund, and possibly one for the Uniform/Trailer Fund.

The Winter Guard Expense, which seemed higher than in past years, was partly due to new uniforms.

2010-2011 Budget

Gale distributed a work sheet for the 2010-11 Budget. Several modifications were made to the budget at the meeting including reducing the amount of revenue that was estimated for the Bloomington Jazz Festival and its Concessions; and reducing expense lines for Marching Band and staff for Winter Guard.

Due to these changes, a new budget will be presented for approval at the first Band Booster meeting of the year in August.

VOTE: Becky Connor motioned to approve making changes at that time; Susie Graham seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

Volunteer Opportunities

The Band Boosters is still in need of a president and treasurer. Vicki Polanski is considering assuming the role of president; Richard VanArsdel agreed to become treasurer.

Student Accounts

At the end of this school year, the money left over in the student accounts of graduating seniors, and non-returning students totals \$1787.32.

VOTE: Janis Stockhouse motioned to allocate all of the graduating senior account money to the general fund. Susie Graham seconded the motion. A vote was taken and was unanimously passed to allocate the money to the general fund.

Yearbook

The yearbook was pretty successful this year: 76 ads sold, and 28 students participating with sales in 2010 vs. 80 ads sold and 29 students participating in 2009.

Director's Report

Janis Stockhouse requested that there be a simple reception at the end of the concert band concerts coming up, suggesting that freshman and sophomore parents help set up and serve. Also, she would like to encourage better concert etiquette by requesting that all of the bands stay to hear the other bands performing. There will be a scholarship given in memory of former band member Debbie Cardwell Peterson.

Thomas Wilson reported that the upper parking lot is going to be resurfaced over the summer, with a tower installed at the east end of the parking lot
