### **Agenda**

#### **August Minutes were distributed to attendees.**

VOTE: A motion was made to approve the August minutes. The motion was seconded. A vote was taken and the minutes were unanimously approved.

### **Treasurer and Financial Report**

Gale Nichols distributed the financial report to the attendees. She reports that the Marching Band expenses are on target. There was a question about the percentage of families who have paid their membership dues. That will be looked into.

VOTE: A motion was made to approve the financial report. The motion was seconded. A vote was taken and the financial report was unanimously approved.

#### **Jazz Under the Stars (JUTS)**

Gale Nichols, JUTS chairperson for 2008, reported that Jazz Under the Stars was a huge success and made over \$9000. Things that contributed to that success included: garnering more sponsorships (both family and business); lower costs on rental items; and including more student musicians. Conversely, there were several factors that may have had a negative effect on the event: scheduling it on a holiday weekend; competition for another benefit in town (Chef’s Challenge); and the event may be too expensive.

Thank you to Gale and the Jazz Under the Stars committee for their hard work and success on this year’s event.

As soon as we know the 2009 Football schedule, we can begin mapping out which weekends the event might be held next year. A chair for the 2009 event should be announced soon.

#### **Football Concessions**

The concession stand for the first football season was a success. The second game did not provide as much concession revenue. The North-South game is coming up, with hopes for more concession revenue.

The marching band is gearing up for its first competition on Saturday, September 13.

#### **Bloomington Jazz Fest**

The Bloomington Jazz Fest, scheduled for December 12 & 13, will be held at BHSN this year. The Band Boosters will provide volunteers to work the event and provide concessions for sale. Julia Copeland has agreed to help brainstorm some strategies for the event. Janis will contact the Athletics department about using the gym balcony for band storage. She is also exploring the possibility of finding a sponsor for the event.

On a side note: Janis will also talk to the Athletic department about the need for the Pep Band for basketball games.

Another one of the Band Boosters large fundraising events is the family-friendly Mardi Gras celebration. It is scheduled for Tuesday, February 24, 2009. Jenny Shedd and Cindy Creek have agreed to co-chair the event again this year, and Jocelyn Ellison and Ann Buehler will do the silent auction baskets again this year. We'd like to make a special reach to the Elementary and Middle Schools, perhaps inviting the Tri North band to perform.
