Fundraising

MARCHING BAND TRIP

Adrienne Kozacek reported on the latest in trip fundraising developments.

- The restaurant fundraiser at BJ's exceeded expectations, generating \$329. Gavin Everett, the manager, was very cooperative and eager to work with us in the future. In fact, BJ's has offered to donate a meal for marching band chow in the fall and perhaps root beer floats for bandcamp.
- There was a silent auction held at the 3/1 Band-o-rama that generated \$190. There are hopes to do more silent auctions at both concerts in May.
- There are upcoming restaurant fundraisers at Applebees on 4/3 and Panera on 4/24 respectively.
- When these next emails are sent out notifying families about the upcoming fundraisers, they will be coordinated with the SCRIP emails in hopes of getting more people using the SCRIP program as a fundraising avenue.

MATTRESS SALE

- Winter guard is preparing for finals. They placed third in their last competition out of 14 guards. They are currently practicing at Summit elementary in a full-sized gym. It is hoped that this relationship can continue in the future.

- Symphonic Band will be doing their recording on 3/7 for their audition into the Chicago competition.
